Cameron Jace Quartiers was born in February 2009. He was born 16 weeks too soon and weighed no more than one pound. Although his prognosis was bleak, the love and devotion from his family, coupled with an amazing team of health care providers, gave him a fighting chance. Sadly, Cameron passed away at just 8 months old. But there are other babies who need a chance. By providing this scholarship, we hope to honor Cameron and help a local individual, in the district from which Cameron would have attended school, achieve their goal of becoming an amazing health care provider.

The board of Project: Cameron's Story will award a \$1,000 scholarship to ONE graduating senior from Glens Falls High School who plans to pursue a 2 or 4 year degree in any area of the health care fields. They will also award a \$1,000 scholarship to TWO additional graduating seniors from any high school in New York State who plans to pursue a 2 or 4 year degree in any area of the health care fields.

Eligibility Requirements:

- In good standing, academically
- Attending an accredited 2 or 4 year college
- Pursuing a degree in any area of health care
- Record of voluntarism within the community

Application Deadline is April 30th, 2024

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This will be a "blind" selection process. This means the board that receives your application will NOT get a chance to see your name during the selection process. They will, however get to read your information and your essay. All names and identifying information will be redacted by a third party.
