

# Finals – June 17<sup>th</sup> – June 26<sup>th</sup> 2019

## STUDENT INFORMATION

Friday, June 14<sup>th</sup>: Awards assembly for grades 7-12 1:45 p.m. in the café.

### 1. **Transportation:**

- A. **Morning:** bus will make regular AM runs each morning Monday, June 17<sup>th</sup> through Wednesday, June 26<sup>th</sup>. **There will be NO MID-DAY PICKUP.**
- B. **Mid-day bus runs:** transportation will be available to bring students home at the following times during exam week:  
Monday, June 17<sup>th</sup> - Friday, June 21<sup>st</sup> at 11:30, and Monday, June 24<sup>th</sup> – Wednesday, June 26<sup>th</sup> at 11:30. If transportation is needed at 11:30 on other days, please report to the office.
- C. **Afternoon bus runs:** regular transportation will be provided at 2:30 each day through Thursday, June 20<sup>th</sup>. On, June 21-26 when there will be a regular run at 11:30 and late bus run at 2:30.  
If a student needs transportation after 3:00, they need to report to the office following their exam.

## BOCES

- Friday, June 14<sup>th</sup> will be the last day for BOCES CTE students.
- Monday, June 17<sup>th</sup> will be the last day for Early College & Career students.

### 2. **Dismissal:**

Students not having an exam during any given test period are to report to the designated study hall. Jr. & Sr. High school students scheduled for only the morning sessions will be dismissed at 11:30.

***Students in grades 7-12 should only attend school when they are scheduled for exams.*** There will be supervised study halls for those students who are here and waiting for an exam to begin, or for those who finish early and are waiting for a bus. **Students who are in school need to be under adult supervision at all times.**

### 3. **Conflicts:**

There may be some conflicts in the exam schedule, so students should report conflicts to their teachers as soon as possible.

### 4. **Rules:**

Students in school waiting for exams should report to study hall (café). Students should bring study material to work on during his/her time in the study hall.

***Students are to report to assigned rooms at 8:15 for morning exams and 12:15 for afternoon exams.***

If a student misses a final exam without prior notice to the school, they may lose credit. Contact the Guidance Office if you are unable to attend an exam. **Regents exams may only be given at the scheduled time.**

### **During Exams:**

1. Sit in assigned seats.
2. No talking or communicating to other students at anytime during the exam period.
3. All personal items brought to the exam room are to be placed in the front of the room. Only items used for the test will be with student.
4. If a student is cheating, he/she will receive a “0” for the exam.
5. Students may not leave their seats until the teacher dismisses them.
