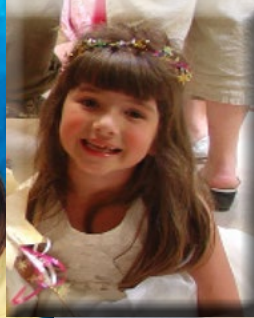
Who Inspired you the most: I'd say my friends have inspired me a lot because they've gone through some hardships that I've never had to go through and they still stay strong despite their bad days.
