I hope you are all doing well. I am writing to provide you with additional updates regarding the new extended school closure, regents exams cancellation, and more.

- As you may have heard, Governor Andrew Cuomo has now extended the statewide school closure to April 29, 2020. Our schools will remain closed during this time to comply with the order and to limit the spread of the COVID-19 coronavirus. Students will continue with at-home instruction through April 29 as directed by the state of New York.
- NYS Regents Examinations: The New York State Board of Regents announced that the Regents
  exams scheduled for the June 2020 testing window have been cancelled. Additional
